

LANGUAGE LESSONS

French lessons (for near-beginners), once a fortnight in Redhill. Capacity for 2 or 3 more students.



Would you like to join this friendly, sociable group of 5 students learning French? The students, mostly members of the Twinning Association, meet once a fortnight (currently on Tuesday afternoons from 2pm until 3pm) in Redhill, alternately at the homes of some of the students. It's not essential to be able to host any lessons to be a member of this group, although helpful if you can. The cost of each lesson depends on how many students attend. If eight students come it's £5.50p. If seven students come it's £6. If six or five students come it's £7. Payment is made at the end of each lesson.

Students need to buy their own course book. The book we are using is "Façon de Parler 1" (5th edition, published 2012) by Angela Aries/Dominique Debney, published by "Hodder Education". We're about half-way through the book. The book is also suitable for independent study, so if you miss the occasional lesson you can keep up with the group by means of self-study.
