Eschweiler Mayor's greeting for Christmas 2022 and the turn of the year 2022/23

Dear fellow citizens!

The past year has not been an easy year for all of us. However, we tackled it together and showed that we want to shape the future of Eschweiler. The flood disaster, the most devastating event in our town after the Second World War, marked its first anniversary. Even though many people were able to return to their homes and apartments and some businesses reopened, there is still a lot to do. The town administration has put its focus on reconstruction in the following year. The signs are particularly good at daycares and schools at the moment and all Eschweiler students will return to study in Eschweiler in 2023. However, due to the ongoing construction work at the Realschule Patternhof and the total demolition of the Willi-Fährmann-School, it will take some time before the students can move into their new buildings.

Also the Jahnstraße Sports Center - with the indoor pool renovated in the nineties - is facing demolition. A new pool with a sports hall will be built at the same place. Preparations are already underway with regard to the demolition and the future design of the new sports centre.

Besides the challenges of reconstruction, we are also feeling the effects of the war in Ukraine. Eschweiler showed itself in solidarity with the people who had to flee Ukraine in the following months. The accommodation for refugees, operated together with Stolberg, (neighbour town) and the numerous private people in our city, took in those seeking help and gave them a new home. But above all the impacts on the energy market directly related to the war, which developed into an energy crisis in this country, represent a huge burden.

In addition to all these challenging tasks, after two years of Corona pandemic, in 2022, we have shown that our city is alive. A wide range of events and culture with countless summer festivals, marksman's festivals, sporting events and large events invite you to escape everyday life for a moment and enjoy life with family and friends.

That's why I feel positive that the Eschweiler City Management Association has succeeded in restarting. Thank you very much to those involved in the board for volunteering for our city. I would like to thank everyone who volunteers in clubs, associations, organizations and in communal politics. They do important work locally in their neighbourhoods, but also in our city's political boards.

In the days to come, but also beyond, we should continue to live with each other, continue to stand up for each other and look out for others.

Wishing you and your families a blessed, peaceful and thoughtful Christmas! Success, personal well-being and above all good health shall be your companion come 2023.
